In pursuance of an Act of Parliament made and passed in the seventh and eighth Year of the reign of King William the third Entituled an Act for preventing Fraud and regulating Abuses in the Plantation Trade

I Wit that William Barnes of Maryland that the Sloop Valentine of Maryland whereof he this Deponent is at present Master being a square sterned Vessel of the Burthen of about Twelve Tons was built in Somerset County in the Province of in the year 1735 a Register heretofore granted for the said Sloop being lost as appears by the Oath of the said Deponent and that he this Deponent is at present Owner thereof and that no Foreigner directly or indirectly hath any Share or part or interest therein

Register granted in Common Form to Charles Palmer of Maryland Merchant for the Schooner the Joyall of Maryland John Tennant Master a square sterned Vessel Burthen about thirty Tons built in the Province in the year 1735 Nathaniel Palmer and Charles Palmer Owners thereof

26 January 1738

Register granted in Common Form to Charles Palmer of Maryland Merchant for the Brigantine Hercules of Maryland a square sterned Vessel Burthen about forty Tons built in Somerset County in the said Province Anno 1736 as appears by a former Register now cancelled, the said Charles Palmer Master, Nathaniel Palmer and the said Charles Palmer Owners thereof
