Labourer the Slave of James Mowall Genl as a proper Ob-  
ject of our mercy the Suit of our Peace and whatsoever ap-  
pertaineth unto us for that the said Negro Isaac the three  
and twentieth day of December with Force and Arms the  
Mansion House of a certain Stephen West in Allhallow  
Parish in the County aforesaid in the night that is to say  
between the Hours of Toward Twelve of the same day the  
said Stephen West and others in the same House then  
being feloniously and Burglariously broke and entered and  
twenty Pounds Current Money of this our Province in  
Money numbered and several Bills of Credit Current  
in Payment with our said Province of the Value of One  
hundred Pounds Current Money one Silver Box of the  
Value of Twenty Shillings like Money the proper Goods  
and Chattels of the said Stephen West in a certain Desk
