 Beloved Robert Gordon and Benjamin Young Esq^r & William
 Rogers Gent Justices of Oyer and Terminer and Good Delivery
 for our said County of Middlesex and Nevertheless Grant
 unto him our firm Pardon will not that he suffer any
 Corporal Punishment therefore but that he stand and be
 in the same Right State and Condition to all Intents and
 purposes as if the said Felony and Burglary whereof he
 the said Negro Isaac has been convicted had never been done
 or committed We will our trusty and well Beloved Samuel
