 that after the Expiration of the said twelve months he the said Mi-
 chael Taylor should give two good and sufficient Securities in
 the Sum of One hundred pounds Current Money each for his
 keeping the Peace and being of Good Behaviour for the space
 of seven years Upon which Judgments the said Michael Taylor
 was Committed to the Sheriff of Prince Georges County by the said
 Justice and hath ever since remained in Prison under the Custody
 of the said Sheriff and whereas the said Taylor is altogether unable
 to satisfy the said fines and hath a wife and several Children
 in very Indigent and necessitous Circumstances who have no
 visible means of Subsistence without the Labour and Industry
 of the said Michael Taylor Know ye therefore that we
 in Compassion to the unhappy Condition of the said Michael
 Taylor and his family have pardoned Released and Remitted
 and by these presents do pardon release and Remit unto the
 said Michael all and singular the fines and forfeitures aforesaid
 which he hath incurred by reason of his said Imprisonment
 as the said Michael shall satisfy and pay the fees legally and Justly
 due to the said Sheriff for or by Reason of his the said Michael's
 Imprisonment aforesaid.
