 Grace We have pardoned unto Richard Jackson late of S. Lukes Parish in
 Queen Anns County Planter as a proper Object of Our Mercy the suit of
 Our Peace and whatsoever appertaineth untolls for that the said Richard
 Jackson the twenty fourth Day of Septem. Anno Domini 1738 in the Night
 time to wit between the Hours of Eight and Twelve in the Afternoon of the
 same Day with force and Arms &c. the Mansion House of Richard Wells
 at the parish of in the County of being feloniously and Burglariously did
 break and enter and abridge of the value of One Shilling Current Money
 of this Our Province of the Goods and Chattels of the said Richard Wells in
 the same house then being found there feloniously and Burglariously
 did steal take and bear away contrary to Our Peace good Rule & Govern.
 whereof he was convicted before Our trusty and Well beloved Henry Hooper Esq.
 one of Our Justices of Oyer and Terminer and Goal Delivery for Our said
 County of Queen Ann Nevertheless We grant unto him Our full peace
 and will not that he suffer any corporal Punishment therefore but that he
 stand and be in the same flight State and Condition to all intents & purposes
 as if the Felony and Burglary whereof he the said Richard Jackson hath
 been convicted had never been done or committed Witness Our trusty and
 Well beloved Samuel Ogle Esq. Governor of Our said Province this 10th Day
 of May Anno Dom 1739.
