Justices of Oyer and Terminer and Goal Delivery for Our said County of Cecil as appears by the Record thereof transmitted to Our Provincial Court, And Whereas for divers Causes and Considerations witherunto moving We have thought fit to suspend the Execution of the said Sentence We therefore command You that from the Execution of that Sentence or any other Sentence of Death pronounced against the said William Turner You altogether surcease and forbear until Our further pleasure shall be known therein Witness Our trusty and Wellbeloved Saml. Ogle Esq. Governor of Our said Province this 1. Day of June Anno Domini 1739
