Avaton Lord Baron of Baltimore &c<sup>o</sup> To all our Bailiffs and good People  
to whom these Presents shall come Know ye that of our especial Grace We  
have pardoned unto Ann Bullingnee late of Ann Arundel County Spinster  
as a proper Object of mercy the fruit of our peace and whatsoever appertaineth  
unto us for that the said Ann Bullingnee the tenth day of September in the  
twenty fifth year of our Dominion with force and Arms the Mansion House  
of Robert Langford in the same County feloniously broke and entered and  
several Bills of Credit current in Payment by Act of Assembly of our said  
Province of Maryland of the Value of five Pounds ten Shillings current  
Money of our said Province and of the proper Goods and Chattels of the  
said Robert Langford then and there being out of the same House feloniously  
took stole and carried away against our Peace Good Rule and Government
