others his Associates Gent Justices to preserve the peace for the said County  
assigned at the last November Court held for the said County Nevertheless  
We grant unto him Our firm peace and will not that he suffer any  
corporal punishment therefore but that he shall stand and be in  
the same plight State and Condition to all intents and Purposes
