Sworn at Patrick Creagh of Maryland Merchant that the Schooner Elizabeth of Maryland whereof William Scandrett is at present Master being a round sterned Vessel of the Burthen of about twenty Tons was built in New England Anno 1729 and called the Mary the former Register for the said Schooner being lost or mistaid as appears by the Oath of this Deponent, and that the said Schooner was rebuilt in Annapolis Anno 1741 and that He this Deponent is at present Owner thereof and that No foreigner directly or indirectly hath any Share or Part or Interest therein

Register granted in Common form to Edward Rumney of the City of Annapolis for the Schooner Sack of Maryland George M. Clester Master a square sterned Vessel Burthen about twenty Tons built in New England Anno 1733 as appears by a former Register now delivered up and cancelled the said Edw. Rumney thereof

21 July

Resignation in Common form made by the Reverend Mr. Henry Ogle of St. Johns Parish in Baltimore County

Induction granted in Common form to the Reverend Mr. Henry Ogle to be Rector of Portobacco in Charles County
