Pardon issued in common form to Negro George the Slave of Jane Rippon of Kent County Widow convicted for breaking a Warehouse and stealing from thence Goods to a considerable Value

Pardon issued to Francis Sherdine of Cecil County convicted for breaking open the Storehouse of Job John Wards taking out there of Two hundred pounds Paper Currency and sundry Goods of Value, with a Clause therein that the said Sherdine should depart the Province in ten Days

Register granted in common form to William Schandrett of Maryland Mariner for the Sloop Nancy of Maryland the S. William Schandrett Master a square Sterned Vessel Burther about Ten Tons built in West New Jersey & called the Fanny and Molly Anno 1736 as appears by a former Register now cancelled the S. W. Schandrett & James Carle Owners thereof

Register granted in common form to Thomas Henney of Maryland Mariner for the Schooner Susannah of Maryland the S. Thomas Henney Master a square sterned Vessel Burther about twelve Tons built in Kent County Anno 1741 the S. Thomas Henney Owner thereof

Commission issued in common form to Benjamin Young Esq. to be Judge of the Court of Admiralty within the Province of Maryland
