Register granted in Common form to Ochterbridge Howey of Maryland for the Schooner the Endeavour of Maryland a square sterned Vessel of the Burthen of about fifty Tons built in Somerset County Anno 1745 the said Ochterbridge Howey Master and Owner thereof

Register granted in Common form to William James of Maryland Merchant for the Brigantine the James and Martha of Maryland John Bramley Master a pink sterned Vessel Burthen about fifty Tons built at Newcastle upon Tyne Anno 1738 and called the Bon Accord of Aberdeen as appears by a former Register now cancelled the said William James
