 Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore. To all our Bailiffs and Good
 People to whom these Presents shall come. Know Ye that of our especial Grace
 We have pardoned unto Fleetwood Benson late of Frederick County Labourer
 as a proper Object of our Mercy the Suit of our Peace and whatsoever Appertain:
 eth unto us for that the said Fleetwood Benson on the twelfth day of September
 in the Year of our said Seventeen hundred and Sixty four at Frederick County
 assailed with Force and Arms and in Faith One Tun holding of the Price of
 fifteen Pounds Current Money the Goods and Chattels of a certain Hugh
 Terrance then and there being found, then and there feloniously took, stole
 and led away against our Peace Good Rule and Government and contrary to
 the form of the Act of Assembly in such Case made and provided whereof he was
 convicted before our Trusty and Well beloved John Larnall Esq. and others Justices
 of Eyre and Assizes and General Goal Delivery for the County of Frederick.
 Nevertheless We grant unto him our full Peace and will not that he suffer
 any corporal Punishment therefore but that he shall stand and be in the same
 Right and Condition to all Intents and purposes as if the said Felony whereby
 he the said Fleetwood Benson hath been convicted had never been done or
 committed Witness our Trusty and Well beloved Horatio Sharpe Esq.
 Governor of our said Province this Twelfth day of September in the Fifteenth
 Year of our Dominion Anno Domini 1765. Upton Scott Clk. Com.

 without any Ill Hindrance or Molestation of any Person or Persons Whatso:
 ever I have and to hold the said Office of Deputy Surveyor as aforesaid during
 Pleasure hereby granting unto you the said Orlando Griffith two third
 parts of all Fees that shall accrue from the said Office. Provided also that
 you the said Orlando Griffith shall from time to time and at all Times
 hereafter
