Frederick Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore to all Our Bailiffs and Good People to whom these Presents shall come. Know ye that of Our especial Grace we have pardoned unto Fleetwood Benson late of Frederick County Labourer as a proper Object of Our Mercy the Suit of Our Peace and whatsoever Appertaineth unto us for that the said Fleetwood Benson on the twelfth day of September in the Year of Our Lord seventeen hundred and sixty four at Frederick County went with force and arms and in forth One Gun holding of the Price of fifteen shillings Current Money the Goods and chattels of a certain Hugh Johnson then and there being found then and there feloniously took, stole and led away against our Peace Good Rule and Government and contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided whereof he was convicted before Our Trusty and Well Beloved John Tammatt Esq; and others Justices of Our and Seimus and General Goal Delivery for the County of Frederick. Nevertheless We grant unto him Our former Grace and will not that he suffer any capital Punishment therefore but that he shall stand and be in the same Right and Condition he all Intents and purposes as if the said Felony wherof he the said Fleetwood Benson hath been convicted had never been done or committed. His Majestys Our Trusty and Well Beloved Horatio Sharpe Esq; Governor of Our said Province this twelfth day of September in the Fifteenth year of Our Dominion Anno Domini 1765.
