day of January in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty Six
at Charles County aforesaid, feloniously, wilfully and of her Malice aforethought
was present, aiding, helping, abetting, comforting, assisting and maintaining
said ~~negro~~ Negroe Jack of Charles County, aforesaid Slave of the aforesaid
Chapman
