former or Informers that shall be summoned or pretend to give Evidence in any Cause  
or matter when and as often as you find the same requisite for our Service. To have hold  
use Exercise and Enjoy the said Office and the perquisites <sup>and Profits</sup> to the same belonging during  
our Pleasure Witness our Trusty and well beloved Horatio Sharpe Esq. Governour  
and Commander in Chief in and over our said Province this Fourth day of June in the

Know ye that Whereas I have and do repose great Trust and Confidence in your  
Skill and Art in Surveying of Land. I do by these Presents depuie constitute and appoint  
you the said Robert Hlee to be Deputy Surveyor of Charles County to the utmost bounds  
and Limits thereof in Surveying or Resurveying any Land in any part of the  
aforesaid County of Charles in as full and ample manner as any Deputy Sur-  
veyor or Deputy Surveyors of the said County have usually done or performed, and to  
Act, do, and perform the same without any let, hinderance, or Molestation of any
