Maryland vs. Frederick, Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland
and Baltimore, Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. in Bedinsfield Lands of Kent County Esq.
greeting. Out of the especial Trust and Confidence we have in your Integrity Prudent
Care and Circumspection we have Ordained Constituted and appointed as by these presents
We do ordain constitute and appoint you the said Bedinsfield Lands to be Treasurer of
the Eastern Shore of this said Province hereby giving and granting unto you the said
said Lands full Power and Authority to ask demand and receive of all Persons concerned
all and singular the dues and Duties payable by any Act or Acts of Assembly of Our said
Province and which Dues and Duties are directed by the said Act or Acts to be accounted
and paid to the Treasurer or Treasurers of Our said Province and a true and just Ac-
count thereof to our executors faithfully to keep, and render the same when thereunto legally
required. To have and to hold the said Office of Treasurer of the Eastern Shore of Our
said Province to you the said Bedinsfield Lands for and during Pleasure with such
reasonable Salary and allowance for the same as in such case have been usually allowed
and given. Witness Our trusty and well beloved Horatio Sharpe Esq. Governor and
Commander in Chief and over the Province aforesaid this fourteenth day of October
in the Sixteenth Year of Our Dominion anno Domini 1766.

Maryland vs. Frederick Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland
and Baltimore, Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To all our Bailiffs and Good People to whom these
Papers shall come greeting. Whereas Peter Beach late of Prince Georges County Labourer
is detained in Our Gaol of Prince Georges County under sentence of Death for a certain Injury
by him committed whereof he was convicted the thirtieth day of July in the Year of Our
Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty six before John Price Esq; and others Justices
of Our Provincial Court, and whereas, of diverse causes and considerations touching the said
Execution he has thought fit to supersede the Execution of the said sentence, We therefore command
that from the execution of that sentence or any other sentence of Death pronounced against
the said Peter Beach you altogether cease and forbear until Our further Pleasure shall
be known therin. Provided that the said Peter Beach continue not within the County
of Prince Georges the space of Twenty four Hours from the time of his delivery from Our
said County and provided also that the said Peter Beach transport himself or cause himself
to be transported out of this Our Province within ten days from the date hereof otherwise this
Our Charter shall be and is hereby declared void and of no effect anything herein
contained to the contrary notwithstanding. Witness Our trusty and well beloved
Horatio Sharpe Esq. Governor of the said Province this Twenty Sixth day of October
