We the Commissioners for Managing and causing to be served and collected His Majesty's Customs, Subsidies and other Duties in that part of Great Britain called England send greeting
Know Ye that We the said Commissioners Have by Virtue of an Act of Parliament made in the Twenty-fifth Year of the reign of King Charles the Second Entituled an Act for the Encouragement of the East Land and Green Sand Trades, and for better ordering the Plantation Trade Do hereby Depute and Impower Mr. James Gibbs to be Comptroller of all the Rates and Duties and Impositions arising and growing due to His Majesty at this time in Maryland in America by Virtue of the said Act Where by he has Power to enter into any Ship, Bottom, Boat, or other vessel; As also into any Shop, House, Warehouse, Storehouse or other Place whatsoever to make Diligent search into any Trunk, Chest, Pack, Case, Truss, or any other Parcel or Package whatsoever for any Goods Wares or Merchandize Prohibited to be imported, or Exported, or whence the Customs or other Duties have not been duly paid; And to
