Frederick, Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore. To All our Bailiffs and Good People to whom these Presents shall come. Know Ye that of our especial Grace We have pardoned unto Fleetwood Benson late of Frederick County Labourer as a proper Object of our Mercy the Suit of our Peace and whatsoever Appertaineth unto us for that the said Fleetwood Benson on the twelfth day of September in the Year of our said Seventeen hundred and Sixty four at Frederick County was seized with Force and Arms and in Faith One Tun holding of the Price of Eighteen Shundo Current Money the Goods and Chattels of a certain Hugh Terrence then and there feloniously took stole and led away against our Peace Good Rule and Government and contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such Case made and provided whereof he was convicted despite our Trusty and Well beloved John Darnall Esq. and others Justices of Peace and Justices and General Goal Delivery for the County of Frederick. Nevertheless We grant unto him our full Peace and will not that he suffer any special Punishment therefore but that he shall stand and be in the same Right and Condition to all Intents and purposes as if the said Felony wherof he the said Fleetwood Benson hath been convicted had never been done or committed. Witness our Trusty and Well beloved Horatio Sharpe Esq. Governor of our said Province this twelfth day of September in the Fifteenth year of our said Dominion Anno Domini 1765. Upton Scott Clk. Com.

Provided also that you the said Orlando Griffith shall from time to time and at all Times hereafter
