Maryland's Frederick Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore To all Our Bailiffs and Good People to whom these presents shall come Know Ye that of Our especial Grace We have Pardoned unto Negro James late of Prince Georges County Labourer the Slave of Rob Taylor as a proper Object of Our Mercy the suit of Our Peace and whatsoever Appertaineth unto Us for that the said Negro James on the eleventh day of August in the Year of Our Lord Seventeen hundred and Sixty five at Prince Georges County aforesaid with Force and Arms and so forth the Meat House of a certain Benjamin Harwood the said Meat House being then and there well Boarded and the Door thereof Secured with a Lock feloniously did Break and Enter and Ten Hams of Bacon Meat and Ten Slices of Bacon Meat to the value of Ten Shillings Sterling Money the Goods and Chattels of the said Benjamin Harwood then and there in the said Meat House being then and there feloniously took stole and Carried away against Our Peace Good Rule and Government and contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such Case made and Provided whereof he was Convict before Our Trusty and well beloved John Cooke Esq. and others Justices of Prince Georges County Nevertheless We grant unto him Our full Pardon and will not that he suffer any Corporal Punishment therefore but that he shall stand and be in the same Right and Condition to all Intents and purposes as if the said Felony whereof the said Negro James hath been Convict had never been done or Committed Witness Our Trusty and well beloved Horatio Sharpe Esq. Governour of Our said Province this Thirtieth day of September in the Fifteenth Year of His Lordships Dominion Anno Domini 1765.
