 a knoweth as y thing to say why the Court here should not proceed to Judgment and Execution against  
 him of and upon the Premises answereth that he hath nothing more to say than what he had  
 afore said. Whereupon all the Jurors the Premises being seen and understood It is considered by  
 the Court here that the said Negro Casar be carried to the Gaol of Baltimore County from whence he  
 remain from thence to the Place of Execution and be there hanged by the Neck untill he be Dead —

 Jack late of Calvert County afo. Slave of a certain Joseph Smith of the said County  
 Planter, not having the fear of God before his eyes but being moved and seduced by the Instiga-  
 tion of the Devil, on the twelfth day of February in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand  
 Seven hundred and Sixty Six at Calvert County afo. within the Jurisdiction of this Court  
 with force and arms and so forth to the Tobacco House of the said Joseph Smith in the  
 said County then and there situated The said Tobacco House having then and there  
 Tobacco
