 having the Fear of God before his Eyes but being moved and seduced by the Instigation of
 the Devil on the fourth day of January in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred
 and Sixty Six with force and Arms at the Parish afo. in Worcester County afo. and within the
 Jurisdiction of this Court met with a certain Negro David late of the Parish and County of Worcester
 afo. the Man Slave of a certain Capt. John of Rockstar County at the Dwelling
 House of a certain John Bonnett of the Parish and County of Worcester afo. with an Intent
