Allen shall from time to time and at all times obey execute and perform such Rules and Orders for his Conduct in the Premises as he shall receive from Us Our Lieutenant Governor or Board of Officers appointed by Our Instructions bearing Date the 22 day of March 1766. And We do hereby Revok Annul and make void all former and other Commissions Powers and Authorities touching the Premises by Us Our Guardians or Predecessors Authority heretofore granted to any other Person or Persons whatever And this Our Commission and the Powers herein granted is to continue du- ring Our Pleasure - Witness Our Trusty and well beloved Horatio Sharpe Esq. Lieutenant Governor and Commander in Chief in and over Our said Province this 26. day of March in the Seventeenth Year of Our Dominion Anno Domini 1766. - signed by order

Maryland's Frederick Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Lord Baron of Baltimore. To all Persons to whom these presents shall come greeting - Whereas Anthony Barriere a Native of France having transported himself to this Province to Inhabit and as a Free Denizen Freedom and Land to him and his Heirs to purchase Know Us that We willing to give due Encouragement to the Subjects of that Nation Do hereby Declare him the said Anthony Barriere to be a Free Denizen of this Our Province of Maryland And do further by Us Our Heirs and Successors strictly enjoin constitute ordain and Command that he the said Anthony Barriere be in all things held treated reputed and Esteemed as one of the faithful People of Us Our Heirs and Successors born within this Our Province of Maryland and likewise any Land Tenements Revenues and other Hereditaments whatsoever within Our said Province of Maryland may Inherit or otherwise Purchase receive take have hold buy or Possess and then may Occupy and Enjoy Give Sell Alien and Bequeath as likewise all Liberties and Franchises of this Our Province of Maryland freely quietly and peaceably have and Possess Occupy and Enjoy as any of Our faithful People born or to be born within Our said Province of Maryland without the least Molestation Vexation Trouble or Grievance of Us Our Heirs or Successors any Custom to the contrary hereof in anywise Notwithstanding - Given at Annapolis under the Great Seal of Our said Province of Maryland this 26. day of April in the Eighteenth Year of Our Dominion over the said Province Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and Sixty eight.
