Maryland<sup>s</sup>. Frederick Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland  
 and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore. To all Bailiffs and good People to whom these Pre-  
 sents shall come Greeting Know Ye that of Our Special Grace we have Pardoned unto Ri-  
 chard Mansfield late of Baltimore County Labourer as a proper Object of Our Mercy the Suit  
 of Our Peace And whatsoever appertaineth unto Us for that the said Richard Mansfield on  
 the sixth day of March in the year of Our Lord Seventeen hundred and Sixty eight at Bal-  
 timore County aforesaid with face and Arms and so forth One White gelding of the Price  
 of Ten Pounds current Money the Goods and Chattels of a certain Richard Rogers there  
 there being found then and there feloniously stole took and carried away against Our  
 Peace Goodrule and Government and contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in  
 case made and provided whereof he was convicted before Our Justice and well beloved  
 John Hepburn and John Deale Bordley Esq<sup>s</sup> Justices appointed to hold the Assizes in  
 Baltimore County Esq<sup>s</sup> on the fifth day of April in the year of Our Lord Seventeen hundred  
 and Sixty eight. Nevertheless We grant unto him Our firm Peace and will not that he  
 suffer any Corporal Punishment therefore but that he shall stand and be in the same  
 Plight and Condition to all Intents and Purposes as if the said Felony whereof he the said  
 Richard Mansfield hath been convicted had never been done or committed. Witness Our Joy  
 and well beloved Horatio Sharpe Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor and Commander in Chief in and over  
 Our said Province this 29<sup>th</sup> day of April in the eighteenth year of Our Dominion Anno  
 Domini 1760. —
