by did break and enter and two Pieces of Silver called Spanish Dollars of the value of nine Shillings
Sterling and one Silk Handkerchief of the value of two Shillings Sterling of the Goods and
Chattels of the said Bordley Bowers in the said Dwelling House then and there being then
and there Feloniously and Burglariously did steal take and carry away against Our Peace good
Rule and Government and contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such Cases made
and Provided whereof he was convicted before the Worshipful Jeremy Ghiselin Esq. and others Justices
of Ann Arundel County at the second Tuesday of August in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand
seven hundred and Sixty eight Nevertheless we grant unto him Our firm Peace and
will not that he suffer any Corporal Punishment therefore but that he shall stand and be
the same Plight and Condition to all Intents and Purposes as if the said felony whereof he the
said Negro Sam hath been convicted had never been done or committed. Witness Our Trusty
