Maryland. Frederick Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland

Presents shall come greeting. Know ye that of Our Especial Grace we have Pardoned unto Edward
Powers late of Baltimore County Carpenter as a proper Object of Our Mercy the suit of Our Peace
and whatsoever appertaineth unto us for that the said Edward Powers on the Twenty first day
of August in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and sixty eight between the
Hours of Eleven and Twelve o'clock in the Night of the same Day with force and Arms at the
County of the Store House of a certain Jonathan Plowman adjoining to the Dwelling House
of the said Jonathan Plowman there situate feloniously and burglariously did break and enter
and Twenty four and an half Yards of white flowered Silke of the value of Four Pounds Sterling
forty Yards of black Silke of the value of six pounds Sterling & fifty Yards of black Sarsin
of the value of five Pounds Sterling of the goods and chattels of the said Jonathan Plowman in the
same Store House then and there being feloniously and burglariously did steal take and carry
away against Our Peace Good Rule and Government, whereof he was convicted at Our Court of
Assize held in and for Baltimore County as on Tuesday the sixth day of September in the Year
of Our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and sixty eight before Our Trusty and well beloved
John Hepburn and Daniel of Saint Thomas Jenifer Esq. Justices of Assize *U. S. p. v. Ager*
Terminer and Goal Delivery of Our Western Circuit Nevertheless We grant him Our firm Peace
and will not that he suffer any Corporal Punishment therefore Provided that he the said Edward
Powers shall within ten Days from the time of his Delivery out of Goal Transport himself
cause himself to be transported out of this Our Province never to return again otherwise the
Our Pardon shall be and is hereby declared Void and of no Effect anything herein contained
