 of Maryland To James Alder of Frederick County Gent. Greeting. Know ye that whereas I have and do
 repose great Trust and Confidence in your Skill and Art in Surveying of Land I do by these Presents
 constitute and appoint you the said James Alder to be Deputy Surveyor of Frederick County to the utmost
 bounds and limits thereof in Surveying or Resurveying any Land in any part of the said County of Frede-
 rick in as full and ample manner as any Deputy Surveyor or Deputy Surveyors of the said County
 have usually done or performed and to act do and perform the same without any let hinderance
 or molestation of any Person or Persons whatsoever To have and to hold the said Office of Deputy Sur-
 veyor during Pleasure. Hereby granting unto you the said James Alder two third parts of all Fees
 that shall accrue from the said Office Provided also that you the said James Alder shall from time
 to time and at all times hereafter receive and comply with all such Orders and Instructions as I
 shall under my Hand appoint and direct You. Given under my Hand and Seal at the
 City of Annapolis this 20. Day of October in the eighteenth Year of His Majesty's Dominion
 Anno Domini 1760

 in your Knowledge and Understanding in the Laws of Great Britain and this Province We have
 nominated and by these Presents do constitute Ordain and appoint you the said Thomas Jennings
 Our Attorney General and Prosecutor of Our Suits Pleas and Actions within Our Province of Mary-
 land whether Criminal or Civil Real Personal or Mixt or of what Nature or Kind soever to be Pro-
 secuted and attended by Yourself in Our Provincial Court of Our said Province of Maryland and in
 such County Courts as You shall Practice and by Discreet and able Persons as You shall for that pur-
 pose from time to time appoint or Depute under You in the several County Courts of this Pro-
 vince where You do not Practice of which You are to take due Care as much as in You Lies And we
 do hereby Grant that You and the Persons so Deputed or to be Deputed under You be and are hereby Per-
 mitted and Authorized to demand require and receive to Your and their proper Uses and Behoof all
 such Salaries Profits Fees and Rewards as now are or hereafter shall be settled granted or due by Us
 (that is to say) to Yourself what is allowed in the Provincial Court and all the Courts where You Prac-
 tice and to Your Deputies what is allowed in the County Courts and because we would not that You
 should want any Assistance Council or Advice in the Management or Prosecution of Our Affairs
 at Law that now or hereafter shall be appointed and allowed of by Us or Our Governor or Commander
 in Chief in and over Our said Province or admitted to Practice by the Law thereof to give and Im-
 part to You their or any of their Council or Assistance in any Matter or thing as You shall or may
 think
