Frederick Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To all Our Bailiffs and good People to whom these Presents shall come greeting. Know ye that of Our Especial Grace We have Pardoned unto Elizabeth Horner late of Somerset Parish in the County of Somerset Spinster otherwise Betty Horner late of the same Parish and County Spinster as a proper Object of Our Mercy the Suit of Our Peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto Us for that the said Elizabeth Horner otherwise called Betty Horner on the Thirtieth Day of April in the Year of Our Lord One Thous and seven hundred and Sixty Nine with Force and Arms at the Parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid One Mare of a Dark Bay Colour of the Price of Ten Pounds Current Money of Maryland of the Goods and Chattels of a certain Levin Ballard then and there found then and there feloniously did steal take and lead away against Our Peace good Rule and Government and contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such Case made and Provided whereof she was convicted at Our Court of Oyer and Terminer and Goal Delivery for Our Eastern Circuit Nevertheless We grant unto her Our firm Peace and will not that she suffer any Corporal Punishment therefor Provided that she the said Elizabeth Horner otherwise called Betty Horner shall before the first day of January next ensuing the Date hereof Transport herself or Cause herself to be Transported out of this Our Province and never to return again or give Security before two Justices of the Peace for her good Behaviour for and during the Term of Seven Years otherwise this Our Pardon shall be and is hereby declared to be Void and of none Effect any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding - Witness Our Trusty and well beloved Robert Eden Esq. Governor and Commander in Chief in and over Our said Province this 3. day of November in the Nineteenth Year of Our Dominion Anno Domini 1769. - Signed by Order

Greeting Out of the Special Trust and confidence we have in your Integrity prudent Care and Circumspection We have ordained constituted and appointed as by these presents we do ordain constitute and appoint you the said William Hemsley to be Treasurer of the Eastern Shore of Our said Province, Hereby giving and granting unto you the said William Hemsley full Power and Authority to ask demand and receive of all Persons concerned all and singular the Dues and Duties payable by any Act or Acts of Assembly of Our said Province and which Dues and Duties are directed by the said Act or Acts to be accounted for and Paid to the Treasurer or Treasurers
