Frederick Auguste Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces
 of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore To all Our Baillifs and Good
 people to whom these Presents shall come greeting. Know ye that of Our especial Grace
 we have pardoned unto Michael Mitchell late of An Arundel County Labourer otherwise
 called Michael Hewitt of An Arundel County Labourer as a proper Object of Our Mercy
 the quiet o' Our Peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto Us for that the said Michael
 Mitchell otherwise called Michael Hewitt on the Twenty fourth day of October in the Year
 of Our Lord, seventeen hundred and Sixty Nine with force and arms at the County aforesaid
 in and upon one Margaret Cumberford then and there being feloniously wilfully and of
 his Malice aforethought did make an Assaunt and that he the said Michael Mitchell
 otherwise called Michael Hewitt with a certain Knife of the value of One Shilling cur-
 rent Money which he the said Michael Mitchell otherwise called Michael Hewitt in
 his Right hand then and there had and held the said Margaret Cumberford in and
 where the left Thigh of her the said Margaret Cumberford then and there feloniously wil-
 fully and of his Malice aforethought did Strike and Thrust giving to the said Marga-
 ret Cumberford then and there with the Knife aforesaid in and upon the above aforesaid
 left Thigh of her the said Margaret Cumberford One Mortal Wound ~~of about two inches~~
 of the Breadth of three quarters of an Inch and the Depth of four Inches of which said
 Mortal Wound the said Margaret Cumberford then and there instantly Died and
 that the said Michael Mitchell otherwise called Michael Hewitt the said Margaret
 Cumberford in Manner and form aforesaid feloniously wilfully and of his Malice
 aforethought did Kill and Murder against Our Peace good Rule and Government where-
 of he was Convict before Our Trusty and well beloved Daniel of Saint Thomas Jenifer Esq;
 and others Justices of an Especial Court of Oyer and Terminer and Goal Delivery held
 at the City of Annapolis on Thursday the Fourteenth day of December Seventeen hun-
 dred and Sixty Nine. Nevertheless we grant unto him Our firm Peace and will not
 that he suffer any corporal Punishment therefore Provided that he the said Michael
 Mitchell otherwise called Michael Hewitt transport himself or cause himself to be trans-
 ported out of this Our Province immediately after his Delivery out of Goal otherwise this
 Our Pardon to be and is hereby declared to be of none Effect anything herein contained
 to the contrary notwithstanding - Witness Our Trusty and well beloved Robert Eden
 Esq; Governor and Commander in Chief in and over Our said Province this 20th day
 of December in the Nineteenth Year of Our Dominion anno Domini 1769 —
