and in whatsover appertaineth unto Us for that the said James at Edward Kicker on the Inventory
day of January in the Year of Our Lord Seventeen hundred and Seventy at Queen Annes County
apprised with force and arms the Store House of a certain Joshua Clark & not being contiguous
to or used with any Mansion House feloniously did break and enter and Inventory Two yards
of Linen of the value of three Shillings Current Money of Maryland each of the said Yards
of Linen five Yards of Cambric of the value of Eight Shillings Current Money each of the

Our Peace Good Rule and Government and contrary to the Form of the Act of Assembly of this
Province in such Case made and Provided whereof he was Convict on the Twenty fourth day
of February in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Seventy before Our true
and well beloved Colonel William Hopper and others Justices of an Especial Court of Oyer
