To all Our Bailiffs and Good People to whom these Presents shall come Greeting Know Ye that of Our Especial Grace We have Pardoned unto Moses Carr late of Frederick County Labourer as a proper Object of Our Mercy the Suit of Our Peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto Us for that the said Moses Carr on the Eleventh day of March in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Seventy at Frederick County aforesaid with Force and ^{army} with One Mare of the value of Ten Pounds Sterling Money of the Goods and Chattels of a certain Philip Sailor then and there being found then and there feloniously stole took and carried away against Our Peace good Rule and Government and contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and Provided whereof he was Convict on Tuesday the Tenth day of April One Thousand Seven hundred and Seventy before Our Trusty and well beloved William Hayward Esq. and others Justices of Our Provincial Court Nevertheless We grant unto him Our firm Peace and will not that he suffer any corporal Punishment therefor but that he shall stand and be in the same Plight and Condition to all Intents and purposes whatsoever as if the said Felony whereof he the said Moses Carr hath been Convict had never been done or committed.
