

on Thursday the Tenth day of January in the Year of Our Lord Seventeen hundred and Seventy One Nevertheless we grant unto him Our firm Grace and will not that he suffer any Corporal Punishment therefor Provided that he the said John Sealby Transport himself or cause himself to be Transported out of this Our Province within Ten Days from the time of his delivery out of Goal and never to return again otherwise this Our Pardon shall be and is hereby Declared to be Void and of no Effect anything herein contained to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding - Witness Our Trusty and well beloved Brother Robert Eden Esquire Lieutenant General and Chief Governor in and over Our said Province this 26. day of January in the Twentieth Year of Our Dominion Anno Domini 1771. - Signed by Order of Scott Esq. Greeting - Whereas Jeremiah Bell Junior and Tobias Bell of Prince Georges County by their humble Petition to Us presented have set forth that a Libel hath been heretofore filed in the Commissioners Office in this Province before the Honourable Walter Dulany Esq. Comissary General in the Names of Humphrey Bell Richard Beall & Sarah his Wife and Clement Wheeler and Lucy his Wife Libellants against the said Petitioners and divers others Defendants that the said Petitioners only appeared and put in an Answer to the said Libel; and thereupon at last January Court the said Libellants obtained a Decree or Sentence of said Court against them the said Petitioners, Revoking and making Null and Void the last Will and Testament of Mr. Jeremiah Bell of Prince Georges County Deceased so far as the same relate to his Personal Estate and also Revoking the Letters Testamentary thereon granted to the said Jeremiah Bell Jun. in which Sentence or Decree the said Petitioners apprehend there is Manifest Error and that the same tends greatly to their Prejudice - And Whereas the said Petitioners have supplicated to Us to Delegate a Power to Commissioners and Delegates to inspect View Examine and correct as well according to the Laws and Customs of Great Britain as Pursuant to the Acts of Assembly of this Province in such Case made and provided the said Sentence or Decree and the same if by Law and Justice so to be done to Repeal and make Void and other Sentence or Decree touching the Matters in the Complaint aforesaid contained to make and pronounce and to Execution to bring or cause to be brought such Order Sentence or Decree still observing the Order of Law and Justice, to which Supplication of the Petitioners aforesaid We giving Assent Do hereby Nominate Delegate and Commissionate You the said Benedict Calvert John Ridout George Stewart Daniel of Saint Thomas Jenifer and Philip Thomas Esq. or any three of you whereof we will that Benedict Calvert Esq. or John Ridout Esq. be one of Our Commissioners or Delegates to View inspect Examine and correct as aforesaid the said Sentence or Decree and the same to confirm or Revoke as You or any three of You shall see Cause and any other Order Sentence or Decree to make and pronounce in the Room thereof touching the Matters in the Complaint aforesaid contained and such Order Sentence or Decree to Execution to bring or cause to be brought. And we do by these Presents Nominate constitute and Appoint James Brooks of the City of Annapolis Gentleman to be your Scribe during the Execution of this Our Commission giving and granting unto You or any three of You whereof
