Maryland Currency the Property of a certain Ignatius Pennicke son of John Pennicke against
our Peace Good Rule and Government and Contrary to the Laws and Customs of the Kingdom
of Great Britain, whereof he was convicted before our Trusty and well beloved George
Plater Esquire and others Justices of an Especial Court of Oyer and Terminer and Goal
Delivery held in and for Saint Marys County aforesaid on Tuesday the second day of July
in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Seventy One Nevertheless
lets We grant unto him our firm Peace and will not that he suffer any Corporal Punish-
ment therefor Provided that he the said Negro Jonathan shall Transport himself or cause
himself to be transported out of this our Province within Ten days from the Time of his
Delivery out of Goal otherwise this our Pardon shall be and is hereby declared to be void
and of no Effect any thing herein contained to the contrary in anywise Notwithstand-
ing - Witness our Trusty and well beloved Brother Robert Eden Esquire Lieutenant
General and Chief Governor in and over our said Province this 26th day of August in the
Twenty first Year of our Dominion Anno Domini 1771 -

feitures Tobacco or Money for Land Marriages Tolls Waifs Strays and Scodands of all Duties
arising from or growing due upon Exportation of Tobacco or Tonnage of Ships and all other
Monies Tobacco or other Effects in any manner or ways now due or hereafter to grow due
whether by Protested Bills of Exchange or otherwise to Us within our said Province hereby
Granting to the said Daniel of Saint Thomas Jenifer Esq. full Power and Authority to Sell and
Dispose of all Lands Tenements and Hereditaments to Us now Escheated or Forfeited to such
Person or Persons as shall agree and pay for them such reasonable Rates in Money as
shall be agreed for with the Consent and Approbation of our Lieutenant Governor or
Board of Officers for the Time being Also to inspect into order manage and Account
for
