beforethought did Kill and Murder against our Peace Good Rule and Government. Whereof
he was convicted before the Worshipful Reverend Justices of Anne
Arundel County Court on the Eleventh day of March Seventeen hundred and Seventy two -
Nevertheless We grant unto him our firm peace and will not that he suffer any corpo-
ral Punishment therefor Provided that he the said Negro Sam Transport himself or
cause himself to be Transported out of this our Province within Ten Days after his
Delivery out of Goal and never to return again otherwise this our Pardon shall be and
is hereby declared to be void and of none Effect, anything herein contained to the contrary
Notwithstanding - Witness Our Trusty and well beloved Brother Robert Eden Esq.
Lieutenant General and Chief Governor in and over our said Province this First day of
May in the Twenty second Year of our Dominion Anno Domini 1772 -

Annapolis May 20. 1772.
Sir Being no longer able to perform my Duty as a Minister in Dorset Parish by
reason of an advanced Age I have at length determined to resign it; for this purpose I came
over to this place and finding your Excellency was not at Home I am obliged to take the
Liberty of Writing to you, I therefore inform you that I am not willing to be continued
Incumbent in the above Parish and you are hereby requested to provide for the same
by the immediate appointment of some Gentleman whom you may think proper -
