Seventy two before Thomas Drather Esq^r and others Justices of
an Especial Court of Oyer and Terminer and general Goal Delivery
Held in and for Frederick County aforesaid Nevertheless We
Grant unto Him Our Full Pardon and will not that he suffer any
Corporal Punishment therefor but that he shall stand and be in
the same Plight and Condition to all Intents and Purposes whatso-
ever as if the said Felonies whereof he the said John Miller hath
been Convict had never been done or Committed
