being then and there well boarded and the Door thereof secured with a lock
feloniously did break and enter and sixty Pounds of Bacon of the value
of twenty Shillings Sterling Money of the goods and Chattels of the said
Elizabeth Wheatly then and there in the said Meat House being found then
and there feloniously stole took and carried away against our Peace good
Rule and Government and contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in
such Case made and Provided whereof he was convicted before the Justices
of Saint Marys County Court on the fourth Day of August seventeen
hundred and Seventytwo Nevertheless We grant unto him Our firm Peace
and will not that he suffer any corporal Punishment therefor but that
he shall stand and be in the same Plight and Condition to all Intentions
and Purposes whatsoever as if the said Felony whereof he the said
Negro Frank hath been convicted had never been done or committed
