

Maryland Frederick Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore To all our Bailiffs and good people to whom these presents shall come greeting. Know Ye that of our especial Grace we have pardoned unto Negro Ben late of Prince Georges County Labourer (the Slave of Walter Bowie) as a proper Object of our Mercy the Suit of our Peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto Us for that he the said Negro Ben on the first day of August in the Year of our Lord Seventeen hundred and Seventy Two between the Hours of Ten and Twelve in the Night of the James Bay with Force and Arms at the County aforesaid the Dwelling House of James Miller there situate feloniously and burglariously did break and enter and One Silver Table Spoon of the value of ten Shillings Sterling, One Pewter Basin of the value of one Shilling Sterling One Blankett of the value of three Shillings Sterling One Oznabug jacket of the value of Sixpence Sterling One Diaper Table Cloth of the value of eight Shillings Sterling and one Double Table Cloth of the value of four Shillings Sterling the goods and Chattels of the said James Miller in the said Dwelling House then and there being then and there feloniously and burglariously did steal take and carry away against our Peace good Rule and Government whereas the said Negro Ben was convicted before the Worshipful John Cooke Esq and others Justices of Prince Georges County Court aforesaid on the Twenty fifth day of August in the Year of our Lord Seventeen hundred and Seventy two Nevertheless We grant unto him our full Peace and will not that he suffer any Corporal Punishment therefor Provided that he the said Negro Ben Transport himself or cause himself to be Transported out of this our Province within fourteen days from the Time of his delivery out of Goals and never to return again other wise this our Pardon shall and is hereby declared to be void and of none Effect anything herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding - Witness Our Trusty and well beloved Brother Robert Eden Esq Lieutenant General and Chief Governor in and over our said Province this Tenth day of October in the Twenty second Year of our Dominion Anno Domini 1772

Know Ye that of our especial Grace We have pardoned unto Negro Tony late of Ann Arundel County Labourer (the Slave of Elisha Harrison) as a proper Object of our Mercy the Suit of our Peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto Us for that he the said Negro Tony on the Twenty eighth day of April in the Year of our Lord Seventeen hundred and Seventy Two at Ann Arundel County and within the Jurisdiction of the same County Court with Force and Arms and so forth the Store House of a certain John Lane not being contiguous to or used with any Mansions House did feloniously break and enter and four Black Worsted breeches Patterns of the value of Ten Shillings each Patterns Ten Yards of Persian Silks of the value of four Shillings each Yard Ten Yards of Nankeens of the value of three Shillings each Yard, Seventeen Silks Handkerchiefs of the value of six Shillings each Handkerchief Ten Cunces of Ballending Thread of the value of lighteen pence each Cunce Six Yards of Chintz of the value of eight Shillings each Yard Six Yards of Cotton of the value of four Shillings each Yard and Two Statts of the value of Ten Shillings each Statt the goods and Chattels of the said John Lane then and there in the said Store House being found then and there out of the said Store House feloniously stole took and carried away against our Peace
