To all Our Bailiffs and good People to whom these Presents shall come Greeting. — Know ye that of Our especial Grace we have Pardoned unto Thomas Johnson the younger late of Frederick County the maker as a proper Object of Our Mercy the Suit of Our peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto us for that the said Thomas Johnson the younger on the first day of July in the year of our Lord One Thousand seven Hundred and seventy two with Force and Arms and so forth at Frederick County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction of the same Court one pair of Gloves of the value of Eighteen Pounds of Tobacco the goods and Chattels of a certain Josias Darby then and there being found then and there feloniously stole took and carried away against our Peace good Rule and Government and contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such Case made and Provided whereof he was Convict before the honorable Thomas Prather Esq. and others Justices of Frederick County Court aforesaid on the Eighteenth day of August in the year of our Lord seven hundred and seventy two Nevertheless We grant unto him our full Pardon and will not that he suffer any Corporal Punishment therefor but that he shall stand and be in the same Right and Condition to all intents and Purposes whatsoever as if the said Felony whereof he the said Thomas Johnson hath been Convict had never been done or committed
