I know ye that whereas I have and do repose great Trust and Confidence in your Skill and Art in Surveying of Land I do by these Presents Depute Constitute and appoint you the said John Hanson to be Deputy Surveyor of Frederick County to the utmost Bounds and limits thereof in Surveying or Resurveying any land in any part of the aforesaid County of Frederick in as full and ample manner as any Deputy Surveyor or Deputy Surveyors of the said County have usually done or performed to act do and perform the same without any let hindrance or molestation of any Person or Persons whatsoever to have and to hold the said Office of Deputy Surveyor as aforesaid during pleasure,

hereby granting unto you the said John Hanson two third parts of all

Fees that shall accrue from the said Office provided also that you the said John Hanson shall from time to time and at all times hereafter receive and comply with all such Orders and Instructions as I shall under my hand appoint and direct you given under my Hand and Seal this 5<sup>th</sup> day of May in the second year of the Dominion of the Right Honourable Henry Harford Esq<sup>r</sup> Anno Domini 1773. —
