Know ye that of Our especial Grace We have Pardoned  
 unto John Hall late of Baltimore County Labourer otherwise called  
 John Philby late of Baltimore County aforesaid Labourer as a  
 proper Object of Our Mercy the Suit of Our Peace and whatso-  
 ever appertaineth unto us for that he the said John Hall other-  
 wise called John Philby on the twenty fifth day of September  
 in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and seventy  
 two with Force and Arms at Baltimore County aforesaid Our  
 yielding of the price of six Pounds twelve Shillings Sterling  
 & Money the proper yielding of a certain John Guyton then  
 and there being found then and there feloniously stole took  
 and led away against our Peace good Rule and Government  
 and contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such Case  
 made and provided thereof he was convicted on the Twenty  
 second day of February in the year of our Lord Seventeen  
 hundred and seventy three before the Worshipful Benjamin Rogers  
 Esq, and other Justices of an especial Court of Oyer and Termin-  
 er and General Goal Delivery held in and for Baltimore  
 County aforesaid Nevertheless We Grant unto him the said John  
 Hall otherwise called John Philby Our firm grace and will  
 not that he suffer any corporal Punishment therefor Provided  
 that he the said John Hall otherwise called John Philby shall  
 within ten Days from the Time of his Delivery out of Goal  
 Transport)
