Robt Eden Lord and Proprietary of the Province of Maryland.
Go all our Bailiffs and good People to whom these Presents shall come
greeting. — Know Ye that of our Especial Grace we have Pardoned unto
Nicholas Fitzgerald late of Frederick County Labourer as a proper object of
our Mercy the suit of our Peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto us for that
he the said Nicholas Fitzgerald on the fourth day of May in the year of our
Lord One thousand seven hundred and seventy three between the Hours
of Two and Four in the Night of the same Day with Force and Arms
at Frederick County aforesaid the Dwelling House of a certain Mary
Luck and Sarah Luck there situate feloniously and Burglariously did break
and enter and Twenty five pieces of Silver called English Shillings of the
value of Twenty five Shillings Sterling Money, four pieces of ~~English~~
Silver called Spanish Dollars of the value of Four Shillings and six
pence Sterling each ^{piece} ~~and~~ one other piece of Silver called an half of a
Spanish Dollar of the value of Two Shillings and three pence Sterling
and four other pieces of Silver called Quarters of a Spanish Dollar
of the value of one Shilling and one Penny and an half penny
Sterling each piece of the Goods and Chattels of the said Mary Luck and
Sarah in the said Dwelling House then and there being found then and
there feloniously and Burglariously did steal take and carry away against
our Peace good Rule and Government, whereof he the said Nicholas
Fitzgerald was Convict before the Worshipful Joseph Wood Esq^r and
other Justices of Frederick County Court on the seventeenth day of
August in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and seventy three
Nevertheless we grant unto him the said Nicholas Fitzgerald our firm
Peace and will not that he suffer any Corporal Punishment therefore but
that he shall stand and be in the same plight and Condition to all Intents
and Purposes whatsoever as if the said Felony whereof he the said Nicholas
Fitzgerald hath been Convict had never been done or Committed. — Witness
our Trusty and well Beloved Robert Eden Esq^r Lieutenant General
and Chief Governor in and over our said Province this Eleventh day of October
in the third Year of our Dominion Anno Domini 1773.
