 and burglariously did Steal take and carry away against our  
 Peace good Rule and Government whereof he was Convict  
 before Thomas Franklin Esq<sup>r</sup> and others Justices of Baltimore  
 County Court on the Monday before the first Tuesday in  
 November in the year of our Lord seventeen Hundred and seventy  
 three, Nevertheless we grant unto him Our firm Peace and will  
 not that he suffer any Corporal punishment therefor provided that  
 he the said Francis Mercier Transport himself or cause himself to  
 be Transported out of this our Province within Twenty days from  
 the Time of his Release out of Goal and never to return again  
 otherwise this Our Pardon shall and is hereby declared to be void  
 and of none Effect any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding
