To William Jordan of Saint Marys County Gentleman Greeting

Robert Eden. Know ye that whereas I have and do repose great Trust and Confidence in your skill and Art in Surveying of Land, I do by these presents Depute constitute and appoint you the said, William Jordan to be Deputy Surveyor of Saint Marys County to the utmost Boundes and Limits thereof in Surveying or Resurveying any Land in any part of the aforesaid County of Saint Marys in as full and ample manner as any Deputy Surveyor or Deputy Surveyors of the said County have usually done or performed and to act do and perform the same without any Let Hindrance or Molestation of any person or persons whatsoever To have and to hold the said Office of Deputy Surveyor during pleasure hereby granting unto you the said James Jordan Two third parts of all Fees that shall accrue from the said Office provided also that you the said James Jordan shall from time to time and at all Times hereafter receive and comply with all such Order and Instructions as I shall under my hand appoint and direct you Given at the City of Annapolis under my hand and Seal This thirty first day of December in the Third year of the Dominion of the Right Honourable Henry Harford Esq^r Anno Domini 1773.
