

being found then and there feloniously did steal take and bear away against our peace good rule and government and contrary to the forms of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided whereof he the said Negro Isaac Dobson hath been convicted before the Worshipful John Brown Esq^r and others Justices of Queen Anns County Court aforesaid on the fourth Tuesday in August in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and twenty four Nevertheless we grant unto him our firm peace and will not that he suffer any corporal punishment therefor but that he shall stand and be in the same slight and condition to all intents and purposes whatsoever as if the said Felony whereof he the said Negro Isaac Dobson hath been convicted had never been done or committed — Witness our Trusty and well beloved Richard Lee Esq^r President and Commander in Chief in and over our said Province this 21st day of October in the Fourth Year of our Dominion anno Domini One Thousand seven hundred and twenty four —

Know Ye that of our especial grace we have Pardoned unto Negro Dick late of Baltimore County Labourer (the Slave of William Russell) as a proper Object of our Mercy the Suit of our Peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto us for that he the said Negro Dick on the sixt^h day of August in the Year of our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and twenty four with force and arms at Baltimore County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction of the said County Court in our Highway there upon one Mary Godson in the peace of God and of us then and there being feloniously did make an Assault and her the said Mary Godson in bodily fear and danger of her life in the Highway aforesaid then and there feloniously did putt and one paper Bill of Credit of the Province of Maryland of the Denomination of one Dollar of the value of Sixty Pounds of Tobacco one other paper Bill of Credit of the said Province of the Denomination of
