

Sixty Dollars of the price of eight pounds Sterling the proper getting of
a certain Richard Brabben and were being found then and there feloniously
taken and carried away against our peace good Rule and Government and
contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and
provided whereof he the said William Vermillion was also convicted
before the Worshipful Thomas Cresap Esq^r and others Justices of
Frederick County Court aforesaid on the said fifteenth Day of
November in the Year aforesaid Nevertheless he grant unto him the
said William Vermillion our firm peace and will not that he suffer any
corporal punishment therefore provided that he the said William
Vermillion shall transport himself or cause himself to be trans-
ported out of this our Province within Forty Days from the Date
hereof and never to return again otherwise his own pardon shall
and is hereby declared to be void and of none effect anything herein
contained to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding - Witness
our Trusty and well beloved Robert Eden Esq^r Lieutenant General
and Chief Governor in and over our said Province this tenth Day of
December in the fourth Year of our Dominion anno Domini 1774
