To

My dear Baillifs and Good People to whom these Presents shall come Greeting
KNOW YE that of our Especial Grace we have Pardon unto Negro Caesar
late of An Arundel County Labourer, the Slave of a certain Lewis Stockell of the said
County as a proper Object of our Mercy the fact of our peace and whatsoever affre-
tameintures for that he the said Negro Caesar on the Night between the First
and Second day of June Seventeen hundred and Seventy Five with force and
Arms and so forth at the County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction of the
same burnt the Meat House of a certain Joseph Mayo Senior the said Meat
House then and there being an Out House and the said Meat House being
also then and there well Blocked and the Door thereof Sealed with a Lock
feloniously did break and enter and one hundred and Sixty pounds of Bacon
of the Value of Seven hundred and Fifty pounds Weight of Tobacco of the Good
and Chattells of the said Joseph Mayo Senior then and there in the said Meat
House being found then and there feloniously stole took and carried away
against our Peace good Rule and Government and contrary to the Form
of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided whereof he the said
Negro Caesar hath been Convict before his Worshipful John Burgess
Esquire and others Justices of An Arundel County Court aforesaid on
the Second Tuesday of August being the Eighth day of the same Month
Seventeen hundred and Seventy Five Nevertheless we grant unto him our
firm peace and will not that he suffer any Corporal punishment herefor
but that he shall stand and bear the same straight and condition to all intent
and purposes whatsoever as if the said Felony whereof the said Negro Caesar
hath been Convict had never been done or committed. Witness our Trusty
and well beloved Robert Eden Esquire Lieutenant General and Chief
Governor in and over our said Province this 11th day of August in the Year of
our Lord 1775 —
