

Jones on the Twenty Seventh day of August in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred  
 and Seventy Five with Force and Arms and so forth at Baltimore County aforesaid and within  
 the Jurisdiction of the same Court the Warehouse of a certain Jesse Rollingsworth Situate  
 in the County aforesaid the said Warehouse not being contiguous to or used with any  
 Mansion House did break open and enter and there peices of Sacket Patterns of  
 the Value of Seven pounds Ten Shillings Current Money of Maryland of the Goods  
 and Chattels of a certain David Sharard in the said Warehouse then and there  
 being found then and there feloniously stole took and carried away against our  
 peace good Rule and Government and Contrary to the Form of the Act of Assembly  
 in such Case made and provided Whereof the said Joseph Jones hath been convicted  
 before the Worshipful John Meale Esq. and Others Justices of Baltimore County Court  
 aforesaid on the Tuesday before the Monday preceding the First Tuesday in  
 September Seventeen hundred and Seventy Five Nevertheless we grant unto  
 him the said Joseph Jones our firm peace and Will not that he suffer any  
 Corporal Punishment therefor, but that he shall stand and be in the same  
 plight and Condition to all intents and purposes whatsoever as if the said  
 Felony whereof the said Joseph Jones hath been convicted had never been done or  
 committed. With this our Trusty and well beloved Robert Eden Esq. Lieutenant  
 General and Chief Governour and over our said province this 6<sup>th</sup> day of November  
 in the Year of our Lord 1775
