 KNOW YE that of our especial Grace We have pardoned unto Joseph
 Bung of Cheney late of Ann Arundel County Labourer, as a proper Object of
 our Mercy the Suit of our Peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto Us
 for that he the said Joseph Bung of Cheney on the First day of August in
 the Year of our Lord Seventeen Hundred and Seventy Two with Force and
 Arms at Ann Arundel County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction of
 this Court one black Horse of the Price of Fifteen pounds Current Money
 of the goods and Chattles of a certain Nicholas Gaspaway then and there
 being found then and there feloniously stole took and Carried away
 against our Peace good Rule and Government and Contrary to the Form
 of the Act of Assembly in such Case made and provided and for that he the
 said Joseph Bung of Cheney on the First day of September in the Year of our Lord
 Seventeen Hundred and Seventy Two at Ann Arundel County aforesaid with
 Force and Arms and so forth and within the Jurisdiction of the same Court
 one dark bay Horse of the Price of thirty pounds Current Money of the goods
 and Chattles of a certain Thomas Cavey then and there being found then
 and there feloniously stole took and Carried away against our Peace good
 Rule and Government and Contrary to the Form of the Act of Assembly in
 such Case made and provided where the said Joseph Bung of Cheney
 was Convict before the Worshipful Nicholas Worthington Esq. and others
 Justices of Ann Arundel County Court aforesaid on the second Tuesday of
 November being the fourteenth day of the same Month Anno Domini
 seventeen hundred and seventy Five. Nevertheless We grant unto him
 the said Joseph Bung of Cheney our full Peace and Will not that he
 suffer any corporal Punishment therefor, provided that he the said
 Joseph Bung of Cheney shall Transport himself or cause himself to be
 Transported out of this our Province within thirty days from the Date
 hereof and never to return again otherwise this our pardon shall and
 is hereby declared to be void and of no effect any thing hereunto contained to the contrary
 in anywise. Notwithstanding Witness our Trusty and well beloved Robert Eden Esq.
 Lieutenant General and Chief Governor in and over our said Province this
 2^d day of December in the fifth Year of our Dominion Anno Domini 1775
