May my letter of the 10th Inst. informated to you what had been

this Resolution I have little hopes of seeing them recede when I meet
them again which the General & M^r Shirley seem to insist on my

Carolina's Virg^a & Pens^a will also be convened & once more solicited
importuned for Supplies. You will observe after what manner the
Lower House express themselves on the Ordinary Grants both in their
Messages to the Upper House & their two Addresses to me of which I
proposed to take some Notice to them in the prosequing Speech that
I had prepared but the Gent^l of the Council thought it more advise-
