which flows into Susquehanna. Two Independent Companies will
I believe remain at Wills Creek during the Campaign & the third
will march to the westward with the other Forces. The three
(Governors above mentioned) from the - Northward came hither the 11th
Inst. & this Day Sonnight proceeded with them to Alexandria, which
place we left again Thursday Morning & they are now on their
way returning to their respective Governs. General Braddock departs
from Alexandria to Day 1st have promised to be with him next Tuesday
Evening at Frederickton where I shall carry till the 5th of May when
all the Troops will be in Motion & he will proceed to Wills Creek &
thence without any stop or Delay for the Ohio. The General & Mr
Shirley seem to expect a visit from the Assemblies of your Adj't Provinces
Pens. Virg & the two Carolinas being once more summoned on the same
Principles that has been so lately & earnestly recommended to them;
Gov'r Virginie intends to hear his ready Compliance by sending
the Virg. Assembly the 5th of May, Gov'r. Morris his the 10th. Gov'r.
Dobbs & Glen will also follow the Example, & propose to take the
advice of your Adj't Council theron next Monday Morning. The Plan

Adj't. a copy of some Minutes taken at a Council which was held
at Alexandria; some Sections thereof will shew your Adj't the Opinions
of the Gentlemen present thereat; to whom the General proposed several
