regard to Vessels having sailed between Taylor's Island & the Main Land were  
entered in the Council Records the Reason that Mr Tusher Mr Calverton  
& Mr Pop give for their not being recorded is that every Thing was left  
to Mr Jennings who sent home both Originals & Copies Duplicates & they  
say the Original Papers are most certainly lodged in the Chancery Office.  
As there will be a very considerable Expence occasioned by running those  
Lines whenever His Ldp & the Proprietaries of Pennsylvania shall give a  
Commission for that purpose it will be necessary that His Ldp give an  
Instruction to the Agent to pay such Sums as the Commissioners may  
with the Governors Approbation draw for to defray the Expence of the  
Commissioners & other incidental Charges. I find by the Conclusion of  
Your Letter that His Ldp is much dissatisfied with Colo Loyd's Manag-  
ment & Neglect & is thoroughly convinced that his Interest suffers greatly be-  
cause Colo Loyd's own extensive Business engrosses too much of his Time  
& Attention. You likewise say that His Ldp being determined to put the  
Management of his Affairs into other hands requires me to consider of this  
matter & to mention some Persons that may with real Security be appointed  
to succeed him. If His Ldp will have an Agent appointed on each Side the  
Bay Philip Thomas Esq & Colo W<sup>m</sup> Goldsborough are I suppose as good  
Men as can be found among the Members of His Ldp's Council & I pre-  
sume he would choose to give the Gent<sup>rs</sup> of the Council the preference, but  
suppose these Gent<sup>rs</sup> or either of them should decline who must in that Case  
be appointed or will His Ldp be satisfied if only one is appointed to the  
Office. I hope His Ldp will not leave it to me to displace Colo Loyd  
(unless he is displaced it signifies nothing to talk of a Successor for  
or resign he never will) or at least if His Ldp does leave it to me I hope I shall  
have a positive Instruction for doing so, but as he is one of the Coun-  
cil I think it will be better for You to write to him & to communicate
